



PMCC MJF Ln. Fatechand Ranka, Dist. Cabinet Secretary Ln. Nikhil Shah,




the school facade, a total donation of Rs. 48,00,000 (Rs. Forty-eight lakhs).

In private hospitals besides dialysis charges, the patients has to bare charges related to dialyzer, tubing, hypotherene injections, pathology charges and various other charges which unfortunately they are required to pay.

We are proud to announce that we charge "Only Rs.200", per dialysis session and other requirements are available at cost price.

Reputed Nephrologist Dr. Abhay Sadre visits Saras Dialysis Center as "Honorary Doctor". From day one he has given his service free. The success of our Dialysis Center is due to his dedication, devotion, involvement, guidance and constant support.

We are proud to inform that 13 of our patients underwent successful Kidney transplants because of the 'Timely and Thorough Professional Treatment', rendered to them at 'Saras Dialysis Centre'. From Feb'09 Till June'22, "Saras Dialysis Centre", has successfully conducted "83,098 Cycles of Dialysis", without a single casualty, and we are proud to also state, that our Dialysis Centre is the only Dialysis Centre in India, operated entirely by a Single Club of 'Lions Club International'.

It has been our continuous endeavor, "To Serve", and when we see the smiles on the faces of our patients going home happy after a 'Successful Session', it cannot be penned down in words.

Saras Dialysis Center is our Permanent Prestigious Project and is successfully running on donation received. All donation received are kept in Fixed Deposit with the Bank, and interest accumulated from such donation is utilized to meet the deficit of the dialysis session. 
